The preliminary diagnosis is called to the ordering physician within 24 hours. Final reports are available within 4-5 working days.

Renal biopsy kits will be provided that contain fixatives for LM, IF, and EM. Also included will be a laboratory requisition form/specimen triage instructions, a pre-paid overnight mailing label, mailing box, refrigerant cool packs, and a biohazard zip-lock transport bag.
