Test Update: Lupus Panel

Dear Regional Pathology Services Clients,

Starting December 3, 2018 the Lupus Anticoagulant Panel (Test Code: LUP) will now include a measurement of heparin-mediated anti-Xa activity (Heparin Quantitative Assay, HEPQT). The addition of this test to the battery allows for identifying patients on newer anticoagulants, which can interfere with testing and result in inappropriate interpretation of results. **The draw** requirement will increase by 0.5 mL to account for the additional test.
