


Dear Regional Pathology Services Clients,

Effective January 14, 2022, the Ova & Parasite test, (Test Code: [OVPCY](#), Acid Fast Stain for Protozoa (Cyclospora & Isospora) will become a sendout. Please note the test code change below.

Specimen requirements:

Stool. Due to the various shedding cycles of many parasites, three separate stool specimens collected over a 5-7 day period are recommended. Preserve 2 g of stool within one hour of collection in AlcorFix. Clients can order the Alcorfix on our supply portal.
