Discontinuation of Flow Cytometric Lymphocyte Subsets for Severe Combined Immunodeficiency (SCID) Testing

Dear Regional Pathology Services Clients,

Effective immediately the Clinical Flow Cytometry Laboratory will no longer offer a Severe Combined Immunodeficiency Panel (SCID) for evaluation of newborns identified clinically or via newborn screening TREC analysis.

Similar T-cell and B-cell subset panels are available at Mayo Medical Laboratories, and can be ordered through RPS as a Special Procedure Blood, test code SPPRB.
